Sec. 9-81. - Littering public places.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to sweep or deposit dirt, trash or other litter into any street or onto any sidewalk within the city. It shall be unlawful for any person to scatter papers or other material detrimental to the order of the city in the public parks, streets, or on any sidewalk.
- (b) Any person who shall violate this section shall be punished as provided in section 1-15 (Code 1998, § 8-3-3)

Sec. 9-82. - Littering private places.

It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit any litter on any private lot or premises whether such lot is owned by the person or another. All trash or litter shall be placed in approved receptacles.
