Citizens University is an 11-session class that allows residents the opportunity to learn how City government works, one department at a time. It encourages residents to become involved in the City's government and enhance their ability to communicate effectively with City officials. City officials, in turn, gain valuable insights into residents' priorities and needs.

BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

Boards and Commissions shape the future of development in the city and make decisions on future Public Art pieces, changes at the Library, creation and upkeep of city parks, and so much more. With annexation complete, Castle Hills residents are now eligible to serve on all 10 Lewisville Boards / Commissions / Committees.
