

# Barge Ownership Change Noted

LEWISVILLE — Ownership of the first fishing barge on Lewisville Lake has undergone minor changes now being approved by the Corps of Engineers.

Joe Jagoe of Denton has purchased interests of Dave Barrow of Denton and Ken Massey of Celina. Also obtaining an interest in the barge is Al Whatley, former manager of similar establishments on Lake Texoma.

Whatley, who will be manager of the barge, helped design and build the Lewisville Fishing Barge and designed the Porthole Fishing Barge at Little Elm. He was manager of a barge and fishing pier at Soldier Creek Resort on Lake Texoma prior to coming to Lewisville.

Recently completing its first full year of operation, the Lewisville Barge attracted an average of 200 persons per day during the year for an estimated total of 65,000 persons, Whatley said.

Jagoe, Barrow and Massey started construction on the barge in September 1958.
