Fishing Barge at Little Elm. He was manager of a barge and fishing pier at Soldier Creek Resort on Lake Texoma prior to coming to Lewisville.

Recently completing its first full year of operation, the Lewisville Barge attracted an average of 200 persons per day during the year for an estimated total of

65,000 persons, Whatley said.
Jagoc, Barrow and Massey started construction on the barge in September 1958.
