WHEREAS, Christian Community Action remains committed more than ever before to serve vulnerable families and individuals with what they need to be overcomers and find success in this world, and

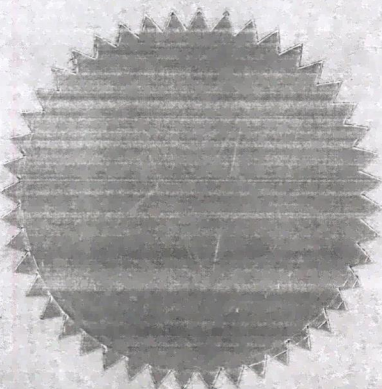
WHEREAS, Christian Community Action will celebrate its 50th year of serving families on April 1, 2023, with its Evening of Hope Gala; and


