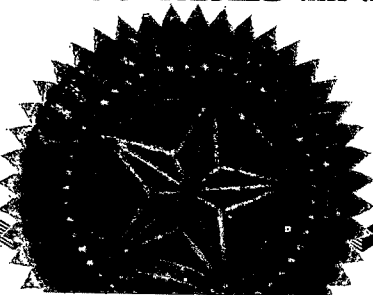
"NATIONAL DRINKING WATER WEEK"


and May 21-27, 2023, as
