



PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Municipal Courts play a significant role in preserving public safety and promoting quality of life in Texas, preserving the rule of law, and the fair and impartial administration of justice; and


WHEREAS, more people come in contact with municipal courts than all other Texas courts combined and public impression of the Texas judicial system is largely dependent upon the public's experience in municipal court; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lewisville Municipal Court is committed to the notion that our legal system is based on the principle that an independent, fair, and competent judiciary will interpret and apply the laws that govern us, and that judges and court personnel should comply with the law and act in a manner that promotes public confidence in the integrity and impartiality of the judiciary;

WHEREAS, Lewisville Municipal Court Judges are not policy makers for the City of Lewisville but are bound by the law and the Canons of Judicial Conduct, and are required to make decisions independent of the governing body of the City Council, city officials, and employees;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the city council of the city of Lewisville, Texas proclaim the week of November 6-10, 2023 as Municipal Court week in recognition of the fair and impartial justice offered by the municipal court of Lewisville.
