## DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the City of Lewisville is located within the geographic area forecasted by the National Weather Service to experience hazardous winter weather; and

WHEREAS, these imminent weather conditions are of such an extreme nature that there is a threat of injury and loss of life to individuals who have prolonged exposure to the outdoor elements; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of Lewisville has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protection of life.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OFLEWISVILLE:

- (1) That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the preservation of life pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
- (2) Pursuant to §418.018(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of Lewisville.
- (3) Pursuant to §418.018(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.
- (4) Pursuant to §418.018(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the appropriate portions of the City emergency management plan, such as those plans outlined in Annex C (Shelter & Mass Care) and the Winter Weather Hazard-Specific Supplement to the emergency management plan.
- (5) That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
