



How to find a parcel number


A property parcel number, also called a property ID, can be found on the City of Lewisville's GIS and in the county appraisal district's property search.

Find your parcel number on the City of Lewisville's GIS


1. Access the city of Lewisville's GIS at <https://maps.cityoflewisville.com/>
2. Find the Layers main menu on the right-hand side of the screen. Add the Parcels layer by checking the box next to Parcels. Once selected the checkbox will change to a checkmark.




If on a mobile device, open the Layers menu by clicking Layers at the top of the screen, then check the box next to Parcels



- Find your property by typing the street address into the search bar, available on the map next to the Layers menu. Search results will appear in a drop-down menu as you type. Select your address from the list. Tip: Don't use punctuation when typing street abbreviations.





- The map will zoom in on your search result and create a search result box. Open the address details by clicking the property directly on the map. A new box will open with a table of property details. Find the property ID. The property ID is the same as the parcel number. Use this number in your STR permit application and monthly hotel occupancy tax report. Tip: You may need to close the search result box to click the property.




Find your parcel number through the Denton County Appraisal District


1. Locate the county's online property search at <https://www.dentoncad.com/>. From the main menu, hover your mouse over Taxpayer Info, then select Property Search from the drop-down list. If searching on a mobile device, open the main menu by clicking on the three stacked horizontal lines on the right-hand side of the screen. Click on Taxpayer Info and then Property Search.



2. Type your street address into the search bar, then click search or hit enter.



3. Find your property from the search results. The property ID is the same as the parcel number. Use this number in your STR permit application and monthly hotel occupancy tax report.



Property ID will either be in the first column or halfway through the list of property details, depending on your browser.
