BACKGROUND

Vista Physical Therapy has moved from 475 Elm Street to 423 Elm Street, Suite 100. The new location is within the Old Town Design District and requires a Letter of Design Approval for a monument. The applicant was previously granted a Letter of Design Approval for a multi-tenant and window sign on August 26, 2024.

ANALYSIS

The application is only for the tenant's sign, and not for the entire monument structure, which is pre-existing. The sign design includes the words "Vista" as the primary text and "Physical Therapy" as secondary text in sans serif font. The letters are white to match the business's brand standards. All letters are made from cut vinyl and applied to a 2" aluminum pan. The sign meets the design guidelines by use of sans-serif lettering at different scales, use of less than five colors, and positive contrast.

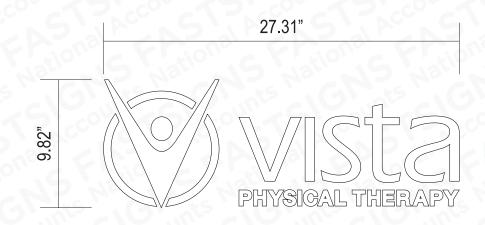
The sign standards for the Old Town Center Overlay District specify that there may be one monument sign with a maximum area of 40 square feet. The monument structure is approximately 27 square feet, meeting the standards. The applicant's tenant sign which will be on the monument structure measures approximately 1.9 square feet in area.

The sign is compliant with Old Town Design District standards.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Old Town Design Review Committee approve the signs as presented.

BACKGROUND

The applicant requires a Letter of Design Approval to make a modification to the front façade of their property. The applicant intends to remove two existing windows and recenter them on the wall they are on. The applicant believes that this will create a more visually appealing frontage, while also providing more light into the bedroom of which the windows face into.

ANALYSIS

A Letter of Design Approval for these windows was approved on January 28, 2019. According to the applicant, the windows were originally installed through the City's Property Enhancement Program (PEP). At the time of installation, the windows complied with building code standards. The standards were updated in 2021, making the windows no longer compliant. However, Assistant Building Official George Babineaux II has stated the applicant is fine to relocate the existing windows, since they were only installed a few years prior.

The applicant proposes taking two existing windows currently spaced apart on the same front façade and placing them side-by-side centered on the wall. The same siding that is used elsewhere on the house will be used to fill in where the windows used to be (Ply Gem Performance Collection, Traditional Lap 4-inch White Horizontal). The windows are Ply Gem 500 Series Single Hung 32" x 54". Around both windows will be a trim, painted Valspar – Pristine Green to match the other green architectural accents on the house. The windows are architecturally compatible with the house and surrounding neighborhood and therefore compliant with Old Town Design District standards.

RECOMMENDATION

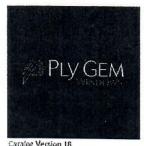
Staff recommends that the Old Town Design Review Committee approve the windows as presented.

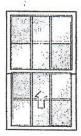

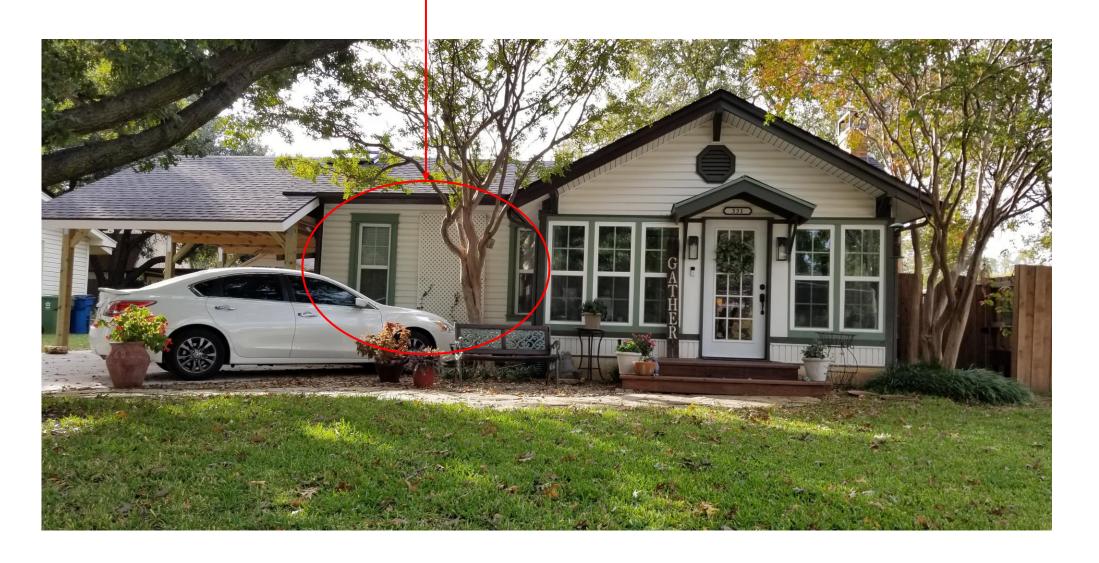

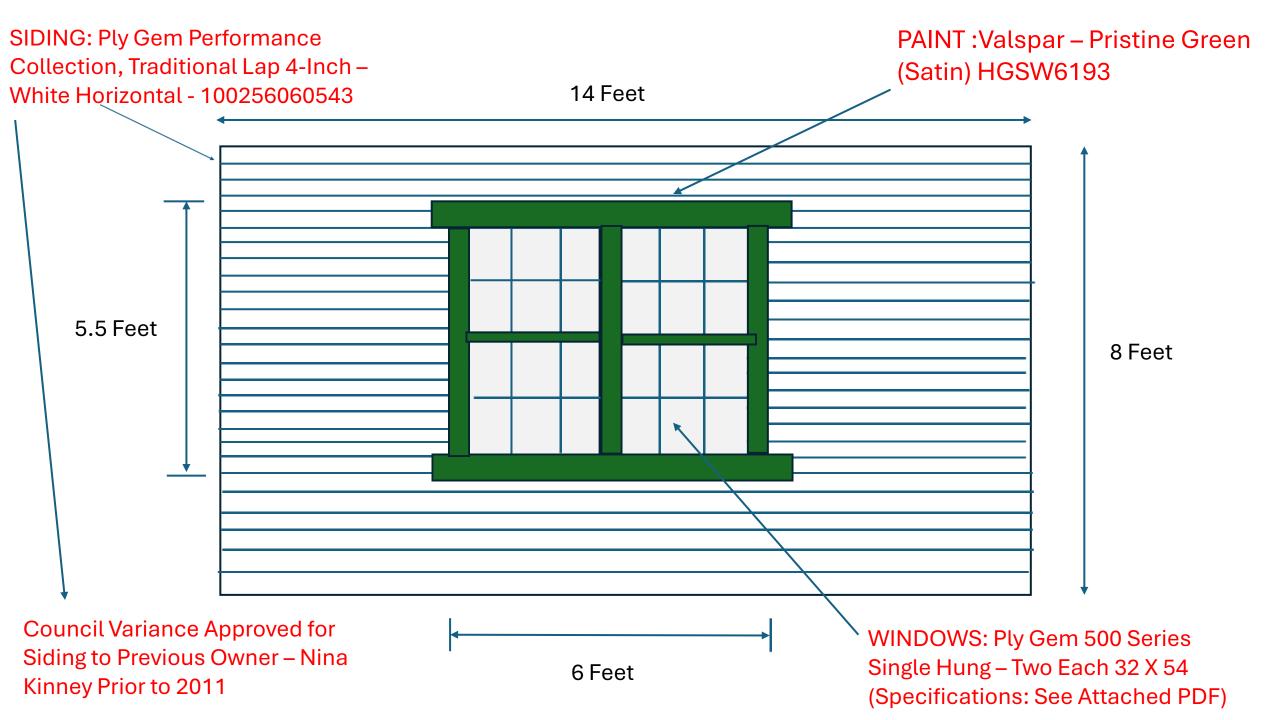

Entry Sign for Old Town in the Median of West Main Street, 70 Feet East of Hatcher Avenue; as Requested by Randy Simon, Parks

Department, City of Lewisville. (24-10-31-LDA)

BACKGROUND

On March 20, 2023, staff presented the concept of entry features to Old Town and locations to City Council. On August 19, 2024, revised designs were presented to the City Council. That meeting and discussion can be viewed online here minute marker 11:51 of the video. Based on the discussion from both meetings more detailed plans were prepared for the option council preferred for the Old Town Design Review Committee to review.

ANALYSIS

The sign design is inspired by the heritage of Lewisville including the Lewisville Feed Mill, Huffines Car Dealership, commercial vernacular buildings brickwork and City Hall.

The proposed sign is a government sign as it is being installed by a governmental agency and therefore does not require a permit, however, it should still comply with Old Town Design District Sign Standards and Guidelines. The closest sign type to the proposed sign is a low-profile/monument sign. Sign standards for the Old Town Design District specify that there may be one low-profile/monument with standards for height, area, setback, materials, and lighting. The sign meets required clearances over the vehicular paths below and standards for building materials. Modifications are requested for height, setback, location, size, and lighting. The Old Town Design Review Committee is authorized to grant these modifications per Section VI.8.2, subsection C.7.c.

The sign materials are brick, caste stone, powder coated metal and perforated metal. These materials are all permitted.

The proposed lighting is a neon-like LED option and downlighting. Downlighting is permitted by the guidelines. LED strip light is like neon tube lighting, but light is not distributed the full way around the tube and can also be substantially brighter. Another difference is that the ends will appear different as they cannot be bent to terminate in the same way as true neon lighting. The previous Prototype IT sign used led strip light to illuminate the letters, they put the sign up and then requested the Letter of Design Approval. The sign has been removed. The Perc sign on the rear of the building using neon tube lighting, Alkey's old sign, since removed used neon tube lighting.

While LED lights use less energy, both types of fixtures would require complete replacement when/if they burn out. Neon signs are expected to last between 8 and 15 years. LED rope lights have a life expectancy of 50,000 hours or 11 years if used 12 hours a day. Neon lights are composed of glass tubes that contain noble gases. The specific gases depend on the color desired, for example, neon for red, helium for pink, argon for yellow, green, blue, or white and mercury for blue. LED lights are composed of plastic or epoxy and contain heavy metals and can have adjustable colors and brightness. Neon uses more energy and is estimated to cost 10% to 15% for the initial installation.

LED "neon" rope lighting has not been used in Old Town in this way. The overall look may be noticeable different than neon lighting. This concern is mitigated by the scale of this project and by the fact the tubes will be applied to resemble neon lighting in the context of a sign to the extent possible. It would also mean future proposals for LED "neon" rope lighting are likely. In some examples of this type of lighting in other applications, the look is very modern and not appropriate for Old Town. If a modification for LED rope "neon" light is approved, it should be noted that each modification is approved case by case based on the overall merits of the design and the project context.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommend that the Old Town Design Review Committee grant a letter of design approval for the sign with the dimension and location modifications requested.

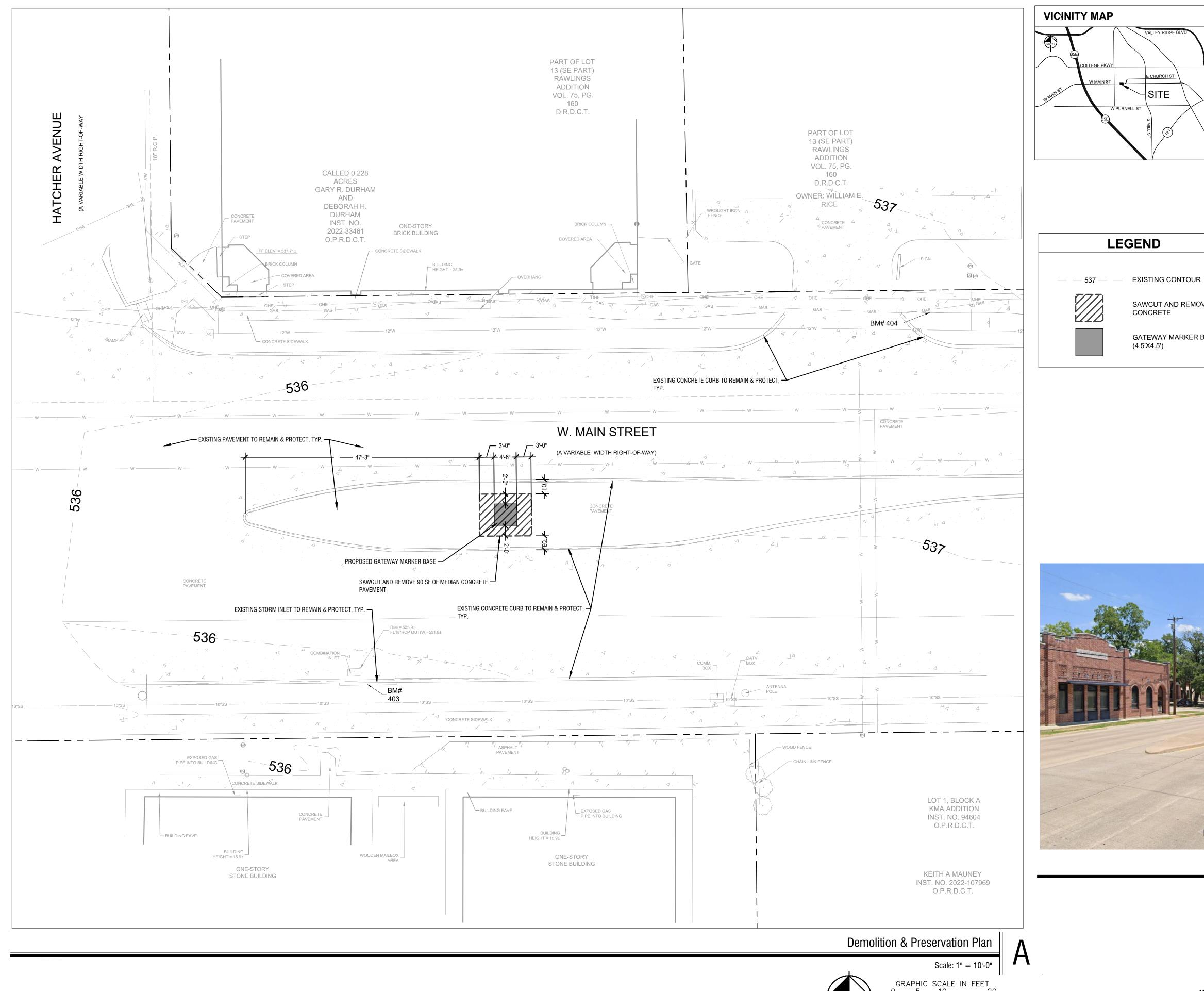

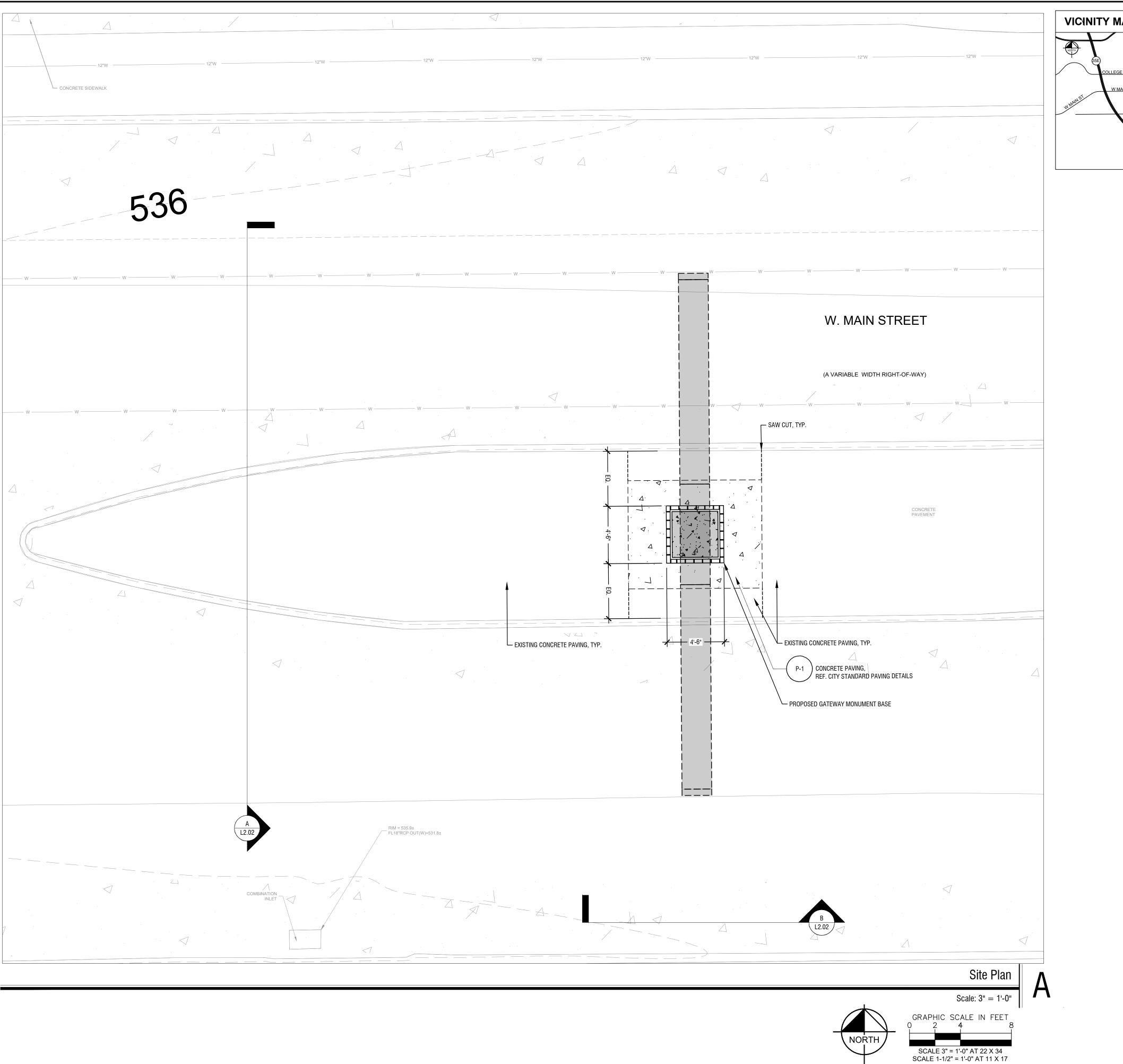

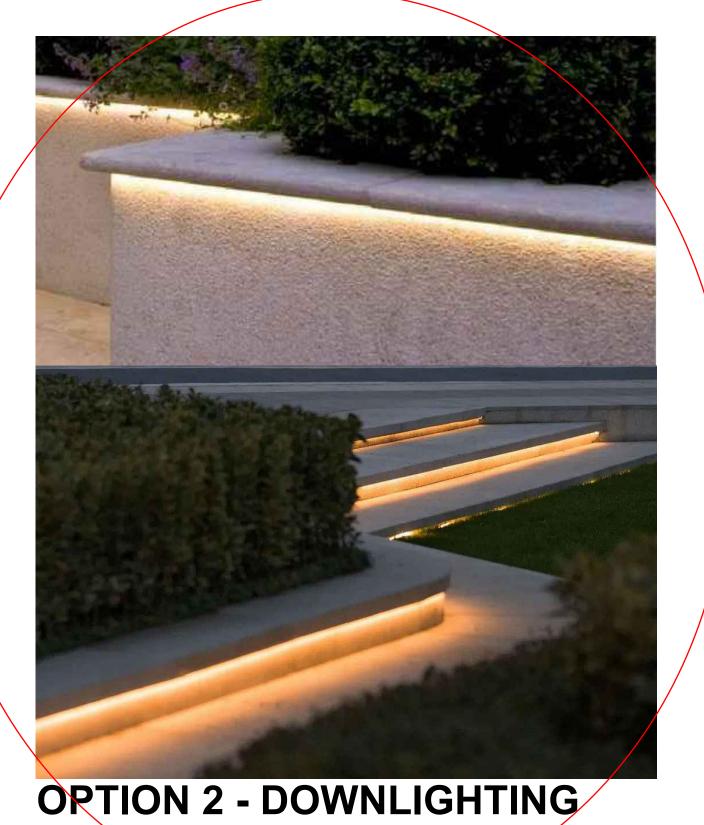
